

Terms and Conditions of Lower Division Transfer Admission | Fall 2023

Provisional Admission

This offer of provisional admission is based on the academic information you reported on your Cal State Apply application. All of your academic information must be verified before you will be allowed to enroll and register for classes at SJSU. Your admission will remain "provisional" until you meet all terms stated below and your official, final transcript(s) passes verification. This offer of provisional admission to the academic plan (major) listed on your admission letter is only valid for this term and may not be deferred to another semester. In addition, it is not possible to change your major prior to enrollment at SJSU.

To ensure your enrollment and attendance at SJSU, all of the mandatory steps below must be completed.

Complete the Next Steps Intent to Enroll process by 11:59 pm on Monday, May 1.

You must sign in to nextsteps.sjsu.edu and notify us of your Intent to Enroll by the date posted to your MySJSU To Do List.

- Indicate that you accept SJSU's offer of provisional admission. Once you
 accept, you are making a commitment to attend SJSU and certify that you
 understand and agree to these terms and conditions.
- Sign up for Spartan Experience for Transfers (SET), which is SJSU's mandatory orientation program for transfers.
- Pay the \$250 nonrefundable enrollment deposit. Your nonrefundable enrollment deposit includes your Spartan Experience for Transfers orientation payment and a deposit toward a portion of your tuition and fees for Fall 2023

Within three business days an email confirmation will be sent to you from the nextsteps@sjsu.edu email address. Print and keep this email—it is your Next Steps receipt for SET orientation.

If you do not complete the multi-step Intent to Enroll Process by the deadline, we will withdraw your application. Please contact nextsteps@sjsu.edu before the deadline if you have any problems completing these steps.

Sign Up for Campus Housing (Optional)

Sign up for campus housing at sjsu.edu/housing or International House at sisu.edu/ihouse

 Send your official, final high school and college transcript(s) postmarked no later than Saturday, July 15, 2023.

 Send official test scores and or college transcripts needed to fulfill admission requirements by Saturday, July 15, 2023.

If you have taken and passed AP, IB or CLEP exams to satisfy any of the CSU admission requirements, request that your official scores be sent to SJSU by July 15, 2023. In addition, if you have completed courses at a community college, please order official transcripts to be sent to SJSU by July 15, 2023.

Attend mandatory Spartan Experience for Transfers (SET)

If you do not attend or leave during any portion of SET orientation you will be blocked from registering for classes and will not be able to attend SJSU in Fall 2023.

Meet the Requirements for lower division admission

An internal review (verification) of your application will be conducted. Your official, final transcript(s) must show that you meet the current impaction criteria and freshman admission requirements in order to pass verification Failure to pass verification will result in your admission being withdrawn. To ensure your provisional admission passes verification, make sure your official, final transcript(s) meets the following criteria:

- Confirm the completion of all of your "a-g" college preparatory coursework
 with a grade of "C-" or better by the end of Spring 2023. SJSU will accept
 grades of "Credit" or "Pass" to satisfy "a-g" requirements completed
 during Winter, Spring, Summer or Fall 2020 terms and during Winter,
 Spring, or Summer 2021 terms. All prior coursework must be graded and
 a grade of "C-" or better must be earned for the course to satisfy "a-g"
 requirements.
- Confirm your date of graduation.
- Earn a minimum of 2.0 in all college coursework.
- Meet the current impaction criteria for your major for the Fall 2023 term.

■ Meet Math Enrollment Requirements

Your math enrollment requirement will depend on your major, complete mathematics coursework, test scores and other factors. You will receive a MySJSU message from Supported Instruction in the second week of May with further details. More information about math course options can be found at sjsu.edu/supportedinstruction, or you can email Supported Instruction at supportedinstruction@sjsu.edu.

■ Monitor MySJSU – EXTREMELY IMPORTANT

SJSU communicates almost entirely by messages and To Do List items posted to your MySJSU (one.sjsu.edu) account. Check MySJSU frequently for updates to your status, important messages, and invitations to upcoming events. You are responsible for compliance with all deadlines posted on MySJSU. Failure to do so may result in your application or admission being withdrawn even if you have signed up for housing, attended orientation, or registered for Fall 2023 classes.

Change of Major

Because of SJSU's campus-wide impaction status, students who were assigned to the alternate major listed on the SJSU application or wish to change majors will follow the process outlined at sjsu.edu/registrar/students/change_of_major

Change of major cannot be made before the beginning of the Fall 2023 semester and is not guaranteed.
