How is admission eligibility determined for non-residents of California?

Your admission to SJSU is typically calculated using a combination of SAT/ACT scores and your GPA. Because the requirement to submit official SAT/ACT scores is suspended for the Fall 2023 admission cycle, applicants will be eligible for admission consideration according to the following:

Residency	Minimum GPA Requirement (a-g coursework)
Nonresident of California	3.0 or greater
California Resident or graduate of a California high school	2.5 or greater

Applicants below these GPA minimum requirements will not be considered for admission at SJSU.

What are the costs for non-residents of California?

Estimated Cost of Attendance 2022-23 for the academic year for non-residents of California:

Tuition and Fees \$17,403 Living Expenses \$24,527 **Total \$41,930**

Amounts are based on full-time attendance (12 units per semester at SJSU) for a 9-month academic year. More detailed information about fees can be found at sjsu.edu/bursar

How is residency determined for tuition purposes?

The determination of residency for tuition purposes affects whether a student pays in-state or out-of-state tuition fees. Out-of-state tuition fees are higher than in-state tuition fees. Just because a student is or has been a resident of the State of California does not mean that they qualify to receive the in-state tuition rate. Certain requirements, established under California law, must be met. The SJSU residence determination dates are:

Fall semester: September 20
Spring semester: January 25
Summer term: June 1

Are there exceptions for non-resident classification?

Exceptions to non-resident classification may be considered for:

- · Members of the military and their dependents
- Certain credentialed employees of school districts
- Certain high school students who have attended three full years of high school in California and attained the
 equivalent to high school graduation

Exceptions cannot be determined without the submission of an admission application and necessary supporting documentation, including the Residency Questionnaire.

Fees Are Subject to Change

The CSU makes every effort to keep student costs to a minimum. Fees listed in published schedules or student accounts may need to be increased when public funding is inadequate. All listed fees, other than mandatory systemwide fees, are subject to change without notice, until the date when instruction for a particular semester or quarter has begun. All CSU listed fees should be regarded as estimates that are subject to change upon approval by the Board of Trustees, the Chancellor, or the Presidents, as appropriate. Changes in mandatory systemwide fees will be made in accordance with the requirements of the Working Families Student Fee Transparency and Accountability Act (Sections 66028 - 66028.6 of the Education Code).

Students should never pay Faculty members directly for any services or goods.

All fees are mandatory with the exception of the Student Involvement and Representation Fee (SIRF) and are assigned a due date based on the date you register.
