- Legal services

- Education

In-Custody Eligibility:

- Release date within 45 days
- Unemployed at release and/or no permanent housing in place
- Referral through Rehabilitation Officer

Community Eligibility:

- Recent release from custody
- Unemployed and/or no permanent housing in place
- Referral from Probation or Parole
- Proof of incarceration in a California state prison
